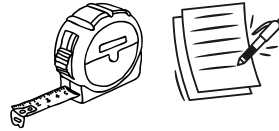


How to Measure

for Wave Curtains

You will need a pen and paper, a tape measure, and a step-ladder if required.



Step 1 -

To measure a Wave heading, measure from where the track will be fitted to the desired drop. We will deduct the track depth for you. If you measure from underneath, this may leave the track partially exposed.

Step 3 -

For curtains finishing at sill or below sill length, measure to that specific point. For a puddled effect, add extra length according to your preferred drape.

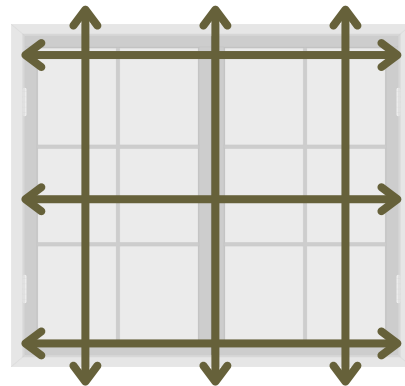
Step 2 -

Once your wave track is installed, measure the drop from the underside of the track down to your desired hem position. If you'd prefer floor-length curtains, measure down to just above the floor, allowing 10-15mm clearance.

Step 4 -

Be sure to use a metal tape measure for accuracy, and take measurements in at least three places across the width — top, middle and bottom— using the shortest width as your final measurement to ensure the curtains hang evenly.
